Fall classroom sessions offered through Triple R Driving School

- **Session one: Begins September 15 (Self Paced/Independent Study)
- **Session two: Begins September 30 (Hybrid; Zoom classes Sept 30, Oct 7, 14 and 21 from 4-6pm)
- **Session three: Begins October 13 (Self Paced/Independent Study)
- **Session four: Begins October 28 (Hybrid; Zoom classes Oct 28, Oct 30, Nov 4 and Nov 11 from 4-6pm)
- ➤ **Session five: Begins November 17 (Self Paced/Independent Study)
- **Session six: Begins December 1 (Self Paced/Independent Study)
- **Hybrid Model Course: Includes Zoom classes each day indicated; additional classroom work will also be assigned for independent study/completion.
- **Self Paced/Independent Study Course: A one hour zoom session will be held on the first day of class to give direction on how to complete the course; students will then work independently on assigned work under the guidance of an instructor.

Six hours of driving time will be arranged with our instructors once the classroom has started for all sessions offered.

- **The cost of the class for all spring sessions is \$355. A \$200.00 deposit is required with registration; no deposit is required if the student qualifies for free lunch. Northeast School District and Easton Valley School District students eligible for free/reduced lunches are also eligible for free/reduced driver education and should indicate that on the bottom of the registration form submitted. Triple R is the contracted driver education provider for Northeast and Easton Valley School Districts; it is the only driver education program that students are eligible for the free/reduced rate. - **Deposits are refundable if notification is given prior to the start of driver education. Refunds of any kind <u>will not be issued</u> once driver education has been initiated. The balance of tuition will be collected before the first day of class and before any driving time is completed (**please plan accordingly**).
- **Students **MUST** possess a **valid instructional driving permit** prior to the beginning of class. Confirmation of enrollment and other information (i.e. Zoom link, etc.) will be sent 2-3 days prior to the first day of class.

Operating Agreement for Triple 'R' Driving School

It is the intent of the Triple R Driving School and affiliates of the company to provide instruction and experience to students of all ages in driver education. Instructors of Triple R Driving School are certified teachers in the state of Iowa. The format of the school may vary depending on the time of year (spring, summer, fall, etc.), although instructional content will remain the same.

Iowa State requirements will be met or exceeded:

- 1. Length of the day in the classroom may not exceed 180 minutes.
- 2. Students will receive at minimum 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the wheel training.
- 3. Students will receive 240 minutes of substance abuse education.
- 4. Students will receive a minimum of 20 minutes of railroad crossing safety.
- 5. Students will be provided instruction relating to the organ donation under the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act.
- 6. The minimum number of times a student will drive in a dual control automobile during the entire course without simulation or range is 12 (30 min sessions) or 6 (one hour sessions).
- 7. A maximum of 360 minutes of range instruction may be substituted for behind-the-wheel instruction.
- 8. All driver education instructors, with the exception of behind-the-wheel instructors, must hold a valid Iowa secondary teaching license and the Driver Education endorsement.

In the unfortunate event of an accident/collision with a student behind the wheel, Triple 'R' will ask that the student or family of the student cover half of the deductible for collision repairs (\$500.00 deductible for collision insurance; \$250.00 responsibility to student or student's family).

It is our intent that all students will complete the course at the program's end. However, students with excessive absences, deficient driving abilities or disruptive behavior (as judged by the instructor) may be dismissed from the program or be required to obtain more driving experience before being issued a certificate of completion. Additional driving experience may be obtained with the instructor or other persons meeting state requirements per request. Additional driving with the instructor will be \$40.00 per hour.

Upon completion of the course, students will be sent a completion letter containing their grade and information on how to obtain their next license. Verification of the completion of the course will be submitted electronically to the Iowa DOT. This submission will allow them eligibility for an intermediate driver's license under the Graduated License System of the state of Iowa, and also allow them eligibility for a school permit (if eligibility criteria is met). All other Graduated License requirements must be met (see graduated license information from the Department of Transportation).

Any student not showing up for their scheduled drive during the course of driver education will be subject to a \$40.00 fee.
